A) ESTES Congress Brussels 2010:

- 1) The topics are: Metaphyseal lesions of the lower extremity, prosthetic replacment after shoulder and elbow trauma, combination injuries of pelvis and acetabulum, trauma and sports, influencing bone healing, research in biomaterials.

osteosynthesis vs hemiarthroplasty
Seibert (Austria): Prosthetic replacement in shoulder injury,
supra/diacocondylar fractures of the humerus
Chiodini (Italy): pathological fractures in metaphyseal regions
Heim (Switzerland): wintersport-accidents/ epidemiology
Popescu (Romania): acetabulum fractures in polytrauma
Meier M (Germany): Instability of the shoulder in sports injuries

B) Prospective study in Europe: financed by the EU. Topic: osteoporosis (actual situation in Europe, how to prevent further fractures...). Skeletal region: proximal femur (proximal humerus was dismissed as incidence and variety of treatment in

Europe might be less uniform). H.J.Oestern will discuss this idea with the people responsible within EU and report again.
